

Facilitator - Part Time Partner Assault Response (PAR) Program

The PAR program provides education and counselling services to individuals convicted or found guilty of a criminal offence against a current or former partner, as well as information and support to the victims of these offences. The program has two primary goals: to enhance safety and to increase offender accountability.

The function of this position is to facilitate group sessions for individuals convicted of domestic violence offences. This position reports to the Program Manager.
