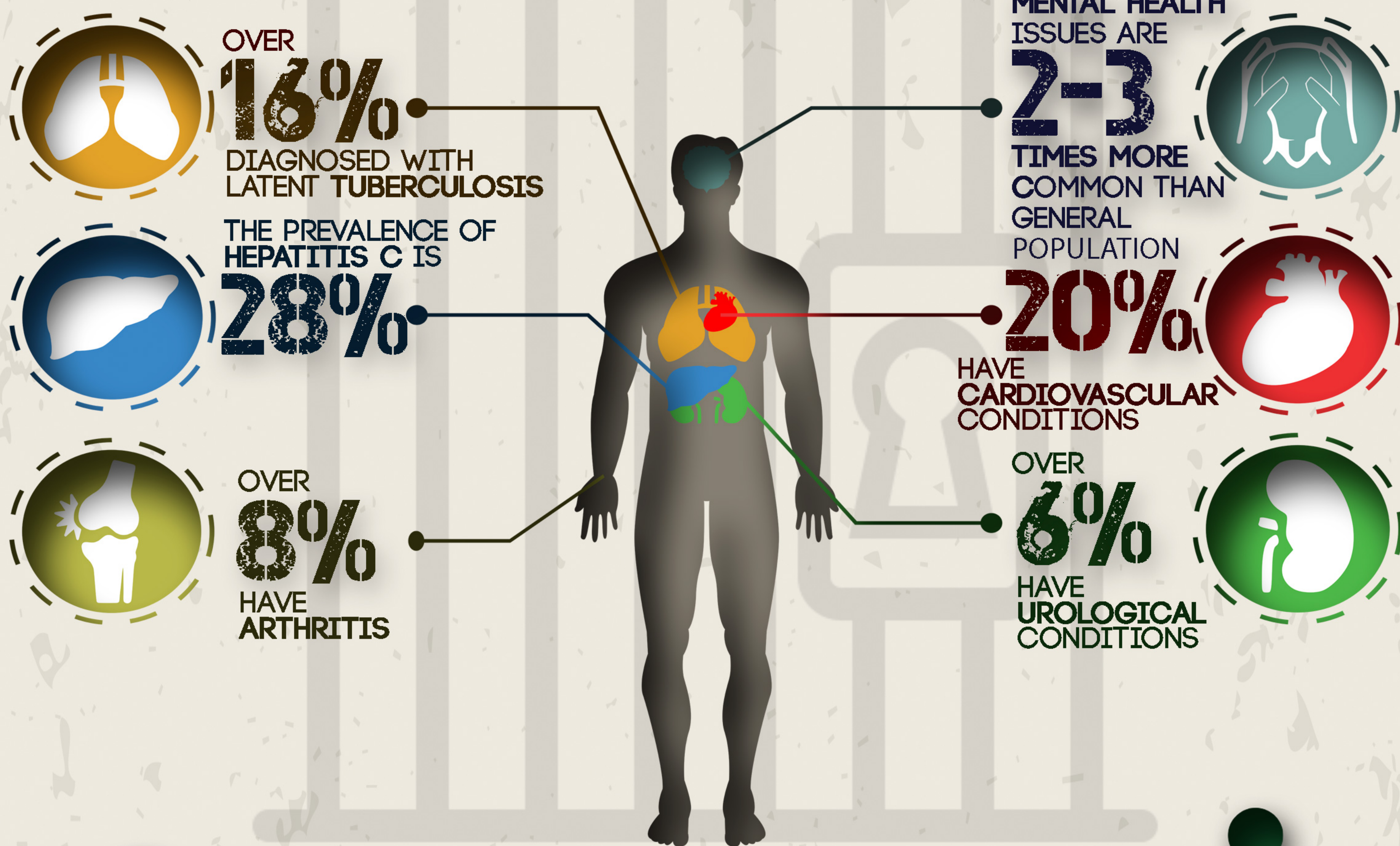


FRACTURED CARE:
