About the program

The program provides case management and 1:1 counselling supports to justice involved youth.

The program addresses the need for

- Individualized counselling
- Community connections
- Social and emotional learning
- Access to basic needs
- Life skills
- Housing supports
- Education supports

Participants will work with a reintegration worker and counsellor to identify and address goals, have access to basic needs, and referrals to community resources.



Who can benefit?

This program is offered to youth ages 12-17 involved in the justice system. This program specifically supports Indigenous, Black, and other racialized youth.

The program is ideal for those residing in or planning to reside in York Region.

What is the structure?

- Case management
- 1:1 counselling sessions
- Virtual or in-person services provided
- Structure based on individual needs and availability
