



## What is the Reintegration Program?

This program provides case management, brief support, referrals to community resources and client advocacy to individuals and families who may have experienced contact with the law or are at risk.

Individuals are supported in goal planning for their own personal objectives and assisted in navigating and accessing community resources.

## Who can Benefit?

This program is offered to individuals and families who may have experienced contact with the law or who may be at risk of contact, and are 18 years of age or older. This program is ideal for those who are residing in or planning to reside in York Region.

## Assistance and Support can Include:

- Intake, assessment and goal planning
- Coordination of discharge plans
- Access to immediate needs such as income supports, food, clothing, shelter and government identification
- Connections to community resources and client advocacy for service
- Access to employment and volunteer opportunities
- Support for families
- Follow-up services

## Record Suspensions

Formerly known as a Pardon, a record suspension allows people who were convicted of a criminal offence and have completed their sentence to have their criminal record kept separate and apart from other criminal records.
