

DIRECT ACCOUNTABILITY PROGRAM (DAP)

WHAT IS DAP?

Direct Accountability Program (DAP-Post-Charge Diversion) is an alternative to formal prosecution for individuals who have been charged with specific minor criminal offences.

This program is court referred and available as a post-charge alternative for accused individuals to be held accountable through community based sanctions.



HOW TO REGISTER

After receiving a court screening with consent of the Crown for DAP:

- Contact our intake line or send an email.
- Please leave us one message ensuring it's clear and concise:
 - Include full name
 - Contact information (phone and email)
 - The best time to reach you.
- Our intake will reconnect with you within 2 business days.
- Once we get contacted, we will arrange a formal intake process.
- You are considered registered for the program once intake is completed.



- Interpreters are available upon request at no cost.
- This program is designed to assist client complete court mandated requirements which may include payments
 - Restitutions payments are facilitated by JHSYR not issued by, please connect with legal counsel regarding discrepancies
