

What is the Reintegration Program?

This program provides case management, brief support, referrals to community resources and client advocacy to individuals and families.

Individuals are supported in goal planning for their own personal objectives and assisted in navigating and accessing community resources.

Who can Benefit?

This program is offered to those 18 years and older, who may be experiencing barriers within their communities due to risk of, or exposure to the criminal justice system. Also available to those facing barriers to stable employment, housing and/or navigating the system.

This program is ideal for those who are residing in, or planning to reside in York Region.

Assistance or Support can Include:



- Intake, needs assessment & goal planning
- Coordination of discharge plans
- Access to immediate needs such as income supports, food, clothing, shelter and government identification
- Connections to community resources and advocacy
- Assisted access to employment & volunteering opportunities
- Supports for families
